The grid will be made up of 8 Karts per race for the Heats, Semis and Finals

There will be 2 to 4 drivers per team

Driver Change over every 5 minutes.

Status will be National.

Grand Final for the Winners is on the cards, but has not been announced as yet.

The top 3 winners winner will receive Awards and Trophies.

Karts will be allotted by Lots.

Karts will run with sealed engines and controlled tyres.

Based upon the success of the Championship, it will be opened up for 2016 for many more Cities and more teams will be invited to participate. There will be Qualifying Rounds in each City prior to the Final Race weekend in each City.

The Championship is currently looking at 24 Schools, 24 Colleges and 24 Corporates at 2 per school/college and 1 per corporate.

In early 2016 - Jan to March, Teams could race their own chassis, sealed engines and the Organisers will supply marked tyres for the races.
